

SQUASH (Laukā)



SOIL

Rich + Light

- Mix the soil
- Take off the rocks
- Put compost or natural Fertilizer

COMPANIONS



Corn
Basil
Mint



Potato



SEEDLING & SUN

Squash likes the sun

- Put the seed 2 or 3 cm deep
- Put the seeds 1 m away from each other
- Put water
- After more than 2 days, the plant will come out of the soil



WATER

- Water the soil in the morning & evening



Do not water the leaves to avoid diseases (powdery mildew)



PLANT CARE

- Take off the weeds
- Take off the damaged leaves
- If you see white spots on the leaves, it's a mushroom called "powdery mildew". You have to take off the damaged leaves and put a decoction of garlic everyday



HARVESTING

Duration of growth: 2 or 3 months

- Harvest the squash when the vegetable is 15 cm long
- When the vegetable is longer than 15 cm, the flavour is not as good and seeds becomes numerous and big
