

RADISH (Moola)



SOIL

Sandy + Rich + Light

- Work the soil 50 cm deep
- Take off the rocks
- Put compost or natural Fertilizer

COMPANIONS



Cress
Cauliflower
Bean
Cucumber



Cabbage
Squash
Grapevine
Potato



SEEDLING & SUN

Radish likes the mix of sun and shadow

- Water the soil and put the seed 3 cm deep
- Put the seeds 2 cm away from each other. After few days, keep only the best one (15 cm away from each other)
- Put water



WATER

- Water the soil in the morning & evening



To have a good harvesting, the soil has to be permanently wet



PLANT CARE

- Add some compost or natural fertilizer to help your plant to grow
- If you see a small black insect on the leaves, it's flea beetle. They like eating the leaves. You can water the leaves and put garlic decoction during a few days



HARVESTING

Duration of growth: little bit more than 2 months

- Dig around the radish to harvest it
- Cut the upper part of leaves
